



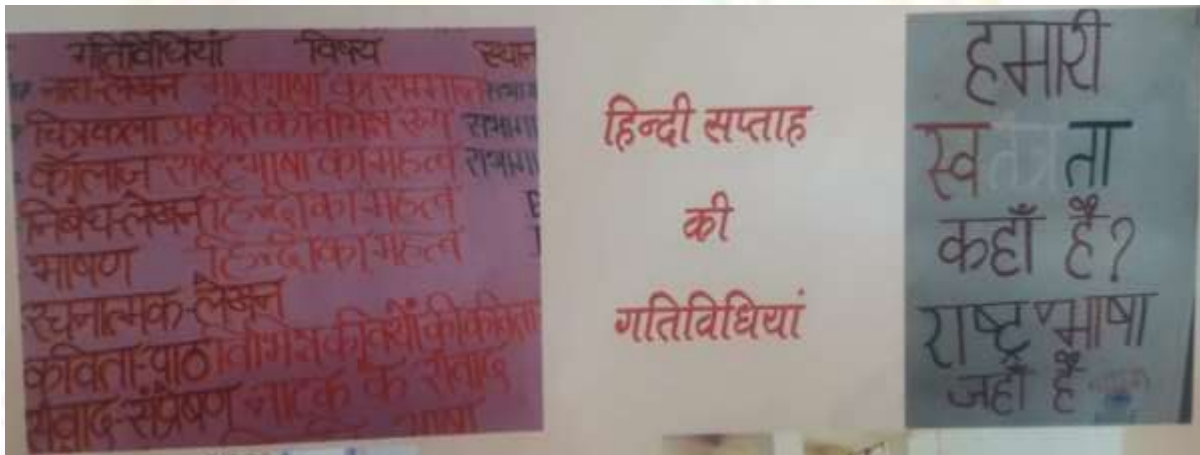
Activities for the Session 2017-18
